Re: Application to Doctoral 2018

Thank you for your enquiry to do a Doctoral degree in Religion, Philosophy and Classics (incl. Theology and Ethics). When applying, please indicate very clearly the programme or discipline in which you wish to pursue your Doctoral and provide a motivation for this choice. The list of programmes available is attached.

a) All students applying for admission into a degree programme at the University need to demonstrate that they have obtained one of the following levels of English proficiency.

1. A pass in an examination equivalent to English at Home or First Additional language level in the NSC (National Senior Certificate) or at the Higher Grade (First or Second Language) at the South African Senior Certificate level (matriculation).
2. A pass in English language at A-level, or O-level (C-symbol or higher), or the International Baccalaureate or equivalent examination.
3. For international applicants who do not satisfy (1) or (2) above and for whom English is a foreign language:
 - an overall band score of 7.0 on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) for Postgraduate studies and 6.0 for Undergraduate studies, or
 - a test score of 550 on the paper version of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or a score of at least 80 on the IBT (electronic) version of the test. See Postgraduate Application Guide for more details.

b) You would have had to have completed at least 5 years of study (3 years Bachelor's degree, an Honours degree, and a relevant Masters degree at a recognised institution, before you can be considered for any of our Doctoral' programmes). ***Students to enter postgraduate studies that do not possess an appropriate previous qualification, but have at least 10 years of appropriate experience are required to submit a CV (2-PAGES) and 2 referee reports.***

c) **International students** please note:

1. "UKZN requires SAQA approval (see SAQA website) on all qualifications obtained from outside South Africa. It is incumbent on the applicant to obtain SAQA approval on their qualifications BEFORE registration as students will not be allowed to register without SAQA approval. Please do NOT come to South Africa if you have not obtained this approval as there have been many delays in the past that have led to students being forced to withdraw from programs". It is compulsory that students who obtain degrees from outside South Africa MUST APPLY to the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA) for evaluation of credentials by sending original academic transcripts to:

2. It is **YOUR** responsibility to apply for a study visa. You must make application as soon as possible to enquire whether or not such a visa will be issued.

d) The attached Fee Guideline Handbook is for 2017 and you can estimate 5% - 10% increase for 2018. In addition to academic, residence and meal costs, you must take into account the costs for books, medical insurance, and residence fees during vacation, transport, laundry, sports and club subscriptions. ***There is a registration fee of R500 and a student levy of R250. Fulltime international students will be required to pay an international levy of R1 480 per semester (as per 2017) only.***






e) Students undertaking full-time research Masters and research Doctoral Studies are exempted from paying tuition fees. Students are eligible for this remission of tuition fees if studies are completed in the minimum prescribed period of study (one year for a Masters by research and three years for a PhD).
