If you are seeking admission into the MTh or MA degree in the Gender and Religion programme, please read the Gender and Religion brochure attached, complete the following assignment typed on a separate sheet of paper and submit it with your application form:

Note that the MTh and MA degrees are higher academic degrees and require both practical experience and the scholarly ability to read, research and write at an advanced level.

Ordinarily students who apply for the MTh or MA will have completed the BTh (Honours) or BA (Honours) in Gender Studies, Religious Studies, or Theology. Other graduates who apply for the MTh or MA may proceed directly to the Master's degree and may also be required to complete certain Honours modules as a prerequisite. Depending on your previous degree you will qualify with either an MTh (Gender and Religion) or an MA (Religion and Social Transformation).

Students applying to the Gender and Religion programme may also chose to refine their focus to work on issues of sexual and reproductive health rights. The programme offers ten competitive scholarships valued at R80,000 each for students who focus on sexual and reproductive health rights. Students qualifying for the scholarship are required to complete the Masters degree within one academic year, and meet other requirements for this cohort of students.

As part of your application, please include an essay in which you reflect on the following questions (should you be interested in the Masters scholarship programme that focuses on sexual and reproductive health rights place a particular emphasis on these questions):

1. What previous studies have you undertaken, and how have these shaped your thinking about gender issues or issues of sexual and reproductive health rights? (500 words)
2. What experience have you had in gender issues or issues of sexual and reproductive health rights, and how do you think that further studies will enhance your capacity to engage in gender issues or issues of sexual and reproductive health rights? (500 words)
3. What theme do you propose to focus on in your dissertation and how does this relate to your previous studies and practical experience? (500 words)
